

## HALF MARATHON RACE

### TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Date: Sunday 31 March 2024

Running Road: 21,0 km Start time: 09:30 a.m.

Starting Point: Town Hall of Ancient Olympia

Finish Point: Town Hall of Ancient Olympia

### Route description

Starting from the Town Hall of Ancient Olympia, through the provincial road, we pass through the beautiful villages of the Municipality, Platanos, Pelopio, Smila, Strefi, returning through the same route, finishing at the Town Hall of Ancient Olympia.

### Eligibility

In order for someone to participate in the running race (21 km) he/she must be at least 18 years old.

### Categories

a) 18th – 35th Year Men – Women b) 35th year and over Men – Women

### Prizes

A medal and kotinos are awarded to each of the first three winners of the ranking in both the Men's and Women's categories and a cup only to the first. The first athlete of each individual category will be awarded a cup. The first three athletes of the Men's – Women's General Classification will be awarded a cup. All runners who finish will be given a commemorative medal and kotinos.

The Traffic Police will deliver the race route to traffic gradually, after the last runner has passed through the supply stations, within the specified time limit.

### **Route description**

Archaeological site of Ancient Elis - Direction to Kalyvia - Kalyvia junction - Avgeio entrance - Avgeio junction - Turn left to Sosti - Exit from Sostis - Intersection with Amaliada - Roupaki National Road in the direction to Amaliada of the same road (road from Roupaki) - Kalyvia - Korai - Ancient Elis - Ermou - Agios Athanasios Square.

### **Eligibility**

In order to participate in the running race (12.8 km) one must have at least 18 years of age. Can participate with parental consent (submission of a solemn declaration and athlete-athlete of younger age.

### **Categories**

a) 18th – 35th year Men – Women b) 35th year and over Men – Women

### **Prizes**

A medal is awarded to each of the top three ranking winners and a cup is awarded only to the first, in the two Men's and Women's categories.

The first three athletes of the General Classification will be awarded a cup.

All runners who finish will be given a commemorative medal.

### **THE ROUTE**

Starting from the Town Hall and heading towards Drouvas Hill, you will turn left, descend to pass next to the banks of the mythical river Alpheus and around the archaeological site of Ancient Olympia, you will climb towards the Olympic Academy and on the left you will pass in front of the entrance of the Pierre de Coubertin Monument, admiring the landscape with the Kronios hill to the East and the Archaeological site to the South, you pass over the most beautiful and so to speak traditional side of Ancient Olympia, the bridge of the river Kladeos, ending again at the town hall of Ancient Olympia.

### **Eligibility**

In order to participate in the running race (4.8 km) he/she must be at least 12 years old.

### **Categories**

a) 12th – 18th Year of Boys – Girls, b) 18th – 35th Year of Men – Women, c) 35th year and over of Men – Women

### **Prizes**

A medal and medal are awarded to each of the first three winners of the ranking, in the one Boys-Girls category and in the two Men's and Women's categories. The first athlete of each individual category will be awarded a cup. All runners who finish will be given a commemorative participation diploma and a medal.
